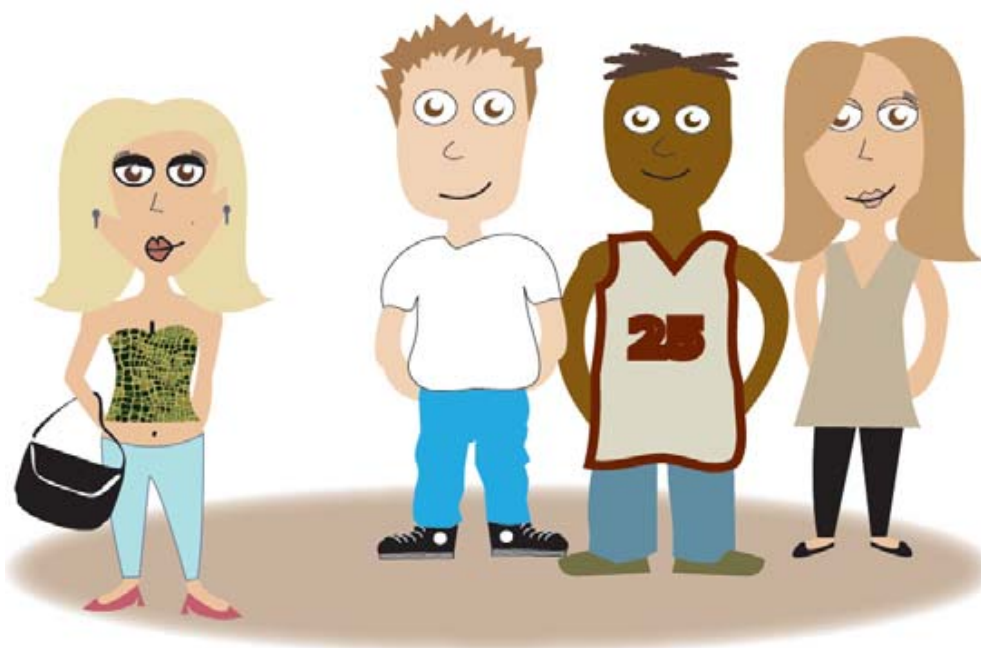

> CONTENTS OF LECTURES

The lectures ICC 1 and ICC 2 are intended as EFL/ESL courses. Before you register for one of them, you should be aware of the fact that the topics are mainly study related, but the focus, however, is clearly set on **training English as a foreign language**.

The topics include, but are not limited to the areas of **business administration, logistics, finance, taxation** and **informatics**. You will also have the chance to have an intercultural insight into the English speaking world.

Please note that at German universities, it is quite usual to **raise your hand** before you say something in class. Give your fellow students time to think about an answer and try to avoid yelling into the silence of the classroom – even though it might seem that no one else responds at once. Your lecturer will know how to proceed.
